



## Participation Rules

Stocker Soccer 5-a-side football leagues are F.A. affiliated and any form of misconduct will result in you and possibly your team being reported to the F.A. who has the authority to impose fines and ban you from this and other leagues.

- **A £25 deposit must be paid by each team upon joining the league which will be returned in full upon the team's completion of the season providing the rules are adhered to**
- **Teams must arrive 5 minutes before kick off (being late will result in the offending team starting with a score deficit of 3-0)**
- The match fee for the team must be paid **before** each match starts. Failure to pay in full on the night will result in your team being given an automatic 8-0 loss.
- **If your team is unable to make a fixture please notify us 7 days in advance (a no show will result in you having to pay both your team's and the opposition team's match fees)**
- Teams must wear matching colours (does not have to be a kit)
- Appropriate footwear must be worn – the game is on Astroturf
- Players must be 16 and over (this is non negotiable)
- **Shin pads must be worn – the referee will check prior to your kick-off: if you are not wearing them you will be asked to leave the pitch**
- The referee's decision is **FINAL**. Any physical or verbal abuse will result in a life ban from the league and it will be reported to the F.A. who may also ban you from other leagues and impose a fine.
- Each team captain must provide all players full names and ages as well as an address, contact number and e-mail.
- If there are any further players wanting to join once your team has been registered, then you must notify Stocker Soccer before they wish to play.
- Games will be played at Wellington College and Edgbarrow sports centres Crowthorne

## Match Rules

- No sliding tackles
- 1 pass back allowed to the goalkeeper in a passage of play
- Throws must be underarm
- Over head height is allowed
- 8 players maximum per team per match
- Roll on roll off subs
- Standard 11-a-side corners
- A yellow card will result in a player being sent off for 5 minutes
- A red card will result in the player being sent off for the entire game (plus possible further suspension)
- The games will be divided into two 18 minute halves and the referee will keep the time
